

# Terms and Conditions: Pixel Dribbble 2015

## by HackingUI and Pixel Perfect Magazine

The competition is an initiative of HackingUI and Pixel Perfect Magazine and is not related directly, indirectly, or is carried out by Dribbble Inc.

This design competition is for the prize of Dribbble invites. 20 winners will be chosen and granted an invite to Dribbble.

The competition will be followed by an exhibition which will print out and display curated designs from the submissions of this competition. Not all submissions will be displayed in the exhibition.

### Guidelines for your design:

Submit a design following the following requirements.

Your design should be made and uploaded in two different sizes and resolutions:

#### 1. The regular Dribbble-like size (one of the following):

- JPG or PNG 800px(w)x600px(h), 72 DPI, maximum of 3mb.
- MP4 800px(w)x600px(h) maximum of up to 10mb.
- Animated GIF 800px(w)x600px(h) or even 400x300px, maximum of only 1mb.

#### 2. Print ready (in case your design would be curated to the exhibition following the contest):

- PDF or JPG, 150mm(w)x150mm(h), 300 DPI, maximum of 7mb

If you're submitting a GIF or MP4 please submit a crop of one of those for now. In the exhibition we might have a way to display those on screens.

Your design can be whatever you'd like it to be, as long as its relevant to whatever is going on in Dribbble.

You can search for inspiration on the page of [Dribbble's Popular Shots](#). **We will not accept any design which we find irrelevant.**

Each candidate **can upload up to 3 different shots**, at any time up to the end of the competition. Do not upload more than 3 shots.

**Very important:** Save the two shots under your name, and with the appropriate suffix to each of them - 72 or 300. For example if I (Sagi) submit my design to the competition, I will call my designs SagiShrieber72, and SagiShrieber300.
